

* Piece C: Technically a 4 7/8" square will work, but I like to use a 5" square cut in half on the diagonal. I then square up the Shaded 4 Patch unit to 4 1/2", trimming away only from the larger triangle.




2. With right sides together, place the marked rectangle on top of the light 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangle at the right-hand edge. Stitch one thread width to the outside of the diagonal line (towards the corner you are going to cut away).




3. Trim away the waste triangle and press the seam open.






4. Repeat steps 1 through 3 measuring over and drawing from the left side on the background rectangle and sewing to the left-hand edge. Each unit should measure $2\ 1/2$ " x $8\ 1/2$ " at this point.





1. Start with a Big Sky Unit, then add connecting corners on each edge using 2 1/2" squares.
